As we drew the curtains on the year 2025, we take a moment to reflect on the inspiring journey of Subi Vidya Foundation (SVF), founded in early 2025. We are delighted to share that our inaugural year has been both meaningful and impactful, marked by diverse programs and initiatives that have positively benefited the community.

Highlights from 2025

We began the year with an online seminar titled “Timeless Wisdom: Bridging the Ancient to Modern Environmental Protection.” It was attended by over sixty participants. This set the tone for a year of sustained engagement and action.

Some of our key activities included:

- March 22, 2025 – ‘World Water Day’ Program

An online event on “Water Conservation-Every Drop Matters” aligned with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) #6: Ensure availability and sustainable management of water and sanitation for all. The program was attended by more than one hundred participants.

- Community Service Initiative

A Poor Feeding Program, followed by the distribution of cool drinks during the summer months, helping to alleviate hunger and thirst for over one hundred people in a rural area.

- Organizational Strengthening

Induction of two highly qualified and experienced professionals as Advisory Members, further strengthening the SVF team.

- Launch of SVF Newsletter *SunShine*

Introduction of our official newsletter to share SVF’s vision, activities, and impact with a wider audience.

- Strategic Partnership

Establishment of a partnership with the World Council of Professionals and Industry (WCPI)- a Scientific, Industrial Research, and Community Development Organization—focused on sustainable development and conservation of natural resources. SVF actively participated in WCPI’s river-related programs.

- Renewable Energy Promotion

Installation of a 3-kW solar power system for a rural household, contributing to clean and sustainable energy adoption.

- Launch of SVF Student Chapter

A significant milestone with the launch of the SVF Student Chapter at DMI College of Engineering, near Chennai. The event held at the college auditorium featured in-person lecture by Dr. Lovelyn Theresa on “*Water Conservation and Audit*.” Over one hundred students and faculty members participated in this launch event.

- **International Representation**

Participation in the 4th International Rivers Summit at Prayagraj, U.P. India where our Founder Chairman, Sri Subi Subramanian, delivered a keynote address.

- **Digital Outreach**

Launch of an attractive and informative SVF website, along with the creation of an SVF Facebook page to amplify ancient wisdom on protecting *Mother Nature* and improve modern living.
